



Information for Colorado Prescribers of Prescription Drugs

Colorado House Bill 19-1131 requires:

- A manufacturer who engages in prescription drug marketing to provide to a prescriber, in writing, the wholesale acquisition cost of a prescription drug when, in the course of conducting business, the manufacturer, representative, agent, or employee provides information concerning the drug to the prescriber.
- A manufacturer, or a representative, agent, or employee of a manufacturer, to disseminate the names of at least three generic prescription drugs from the same therapeutic class, or if three are not available, as many as are available for prescriptive use.
